

Appendix F: Cities and Towns

Overview

This Appendix provides a detailed and informative description of six of the incorporated entities in Canadian County. Three other municipalities have opted not to be included in this particular plan.

Places in Canadian County are rich in pre-statehood history – cities and towns of today that were townsites established on the very first day of the first of the Oklahoma “Land Runs” in 1889, opening to white settlement the “Unassigned Lands” – that play an important role in 21st century Oklahoma’s economy and education.
