**Whereas**, Emergency Managers from across the state as well as here in Canadian County follow a comprehensive Emergency Management Plan involving mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery areas; and

**Whereas**, the Oklahoma Emergency Management Association should be commended for its continued diligence and mission to the citizens of Oklahoma and Canadian County;

**Whereas**, Oklahoma Emergency Managers from around the state will take part in Emergency Management Day at the Capitol on February 26, 2014;
