




Oklahoma Statutes

 - Chapter 19A County Zoning and Planning
 1. Counties Containing City of 180,000 Population
 - § 863.1 – 863.44 Does not apply to Canadian County
 2. County Planning and Zoning
 - § 865.51 – 865.69
 3. City–County Planning and Zoning
 - § 866.1 – 866.35
 4. Counties of Over 500,000
 - § 868.1 – 868.22 Does not apply to Canadian County
 5. Lake Area Planning Commission
 - § 869.1 – 869.7 Does not apply to Canadian County


- ▶ Other towns in Canadian County:

Comparison of Statutes

▶ County Planning and Zoning

- § 865.51 – 865.69
- Effects all of the unincorporated area of the county
- Requires a vote of the entire county
- First possible date for an election – March 8, 2013
- Board members comprised of:
 - 3 members appointed by the Board of Co. Commissioners
 - 1 County Commissioner
 - 1 member appointed by each mayor of each incorporated city or town having a population of 1,000 or more
- “Shall not apply to the erection of farm homes or the erection or use of the usual farm buildings for agricultural purposes or the planting of agricultural crops.”



Comparison of Statutes


▶ City–County Planning and Zoning

- § 866.1 – 866.35 continued
- No countywide vote required – created by a resolution of the Board of Co. Commissioners and the municipality
- Board members comprised of:
 - 4 members appointed by the mayor of the municipality
 - 4 members appointed by the Board of Co. Commissioners
 - 1 member appointed by each incorporated city or town within the jurisdiction of the commission
- “Shall not apply to the erection or use of the usual farm buildings for agricultural purposes or to the planting of agricultural crops...”
